Known History

1964 GSM Flamingo

The history of the car from 1964 until 1977 is unknown. In November 1977 Con Joubert bought the car from a person in Bertrams, Johannesburg for R90.00. The car was a basket-case with the nose, wheels, engine gearbox, headlights, grille, instruments and tail lights all missing. Con Joubert rebuilt the car and used it daily until he sold it to Brian Porter in June 1996. Porter passed away in November 1997. Hein van der Watt purchased the car from his estate in February 1998. The car was in running order with a Gunston orange colour. Hein restored the car and changed the color to Monza red. He used the car on a daily basis until August 2003 when he painstakingly restored the car for a second time. This time Hein replaced the engine with a 1500 pre-cross flow with two 40 side draught Webers and a BCF 3 (290) cam. In August 2010 Neville Lomnitz bought the Flamingo from Hein.
